Do I really have to take IELTS?

- University entrance requirement
 - Usually 6.0 with nothing below 5.5 for UG
 - Can be higher (6.5 is increasingly common)
 - "Equivalent" to English GCSE requirement
- Requirement of your **current** visa (for EF University Preparation)
 - You promised that you would take it in your visa interview
 - Even if you already have the grade that you need for university

Where can I take my exam?

If you need a **visa**

- You must take IELTS for UKVI
- The nearest centres are in London
- London Central is the easiest

If you do **not** need a visa

- i.e. You have a British passport or Pre-Settled Status
- You can take non-UKVI
- You can take this in Oxford

General Arrangements

- We would like to provide transportation together
 - BUT we need to get you all booked on one day
- We will provide transport on **Saturday 28th May**
 - This was by far the most popular in the poll
- Please let me know if **London Central** fills up for this day

Paper or Computer?

- Both are equally valid
- Both are in an exam centre in London
 - No online distance exams
- Both are available at Central
- Usually more spaces for Computer
- Results for Computer arrive after 1 week
- Results for Paper arrive after 2 weeks
- Whichever you are more comfortable with
- Paper available morning only; Computer has morning or afternoon times
- Our coach will arrive for the **morning** session

How do I book?

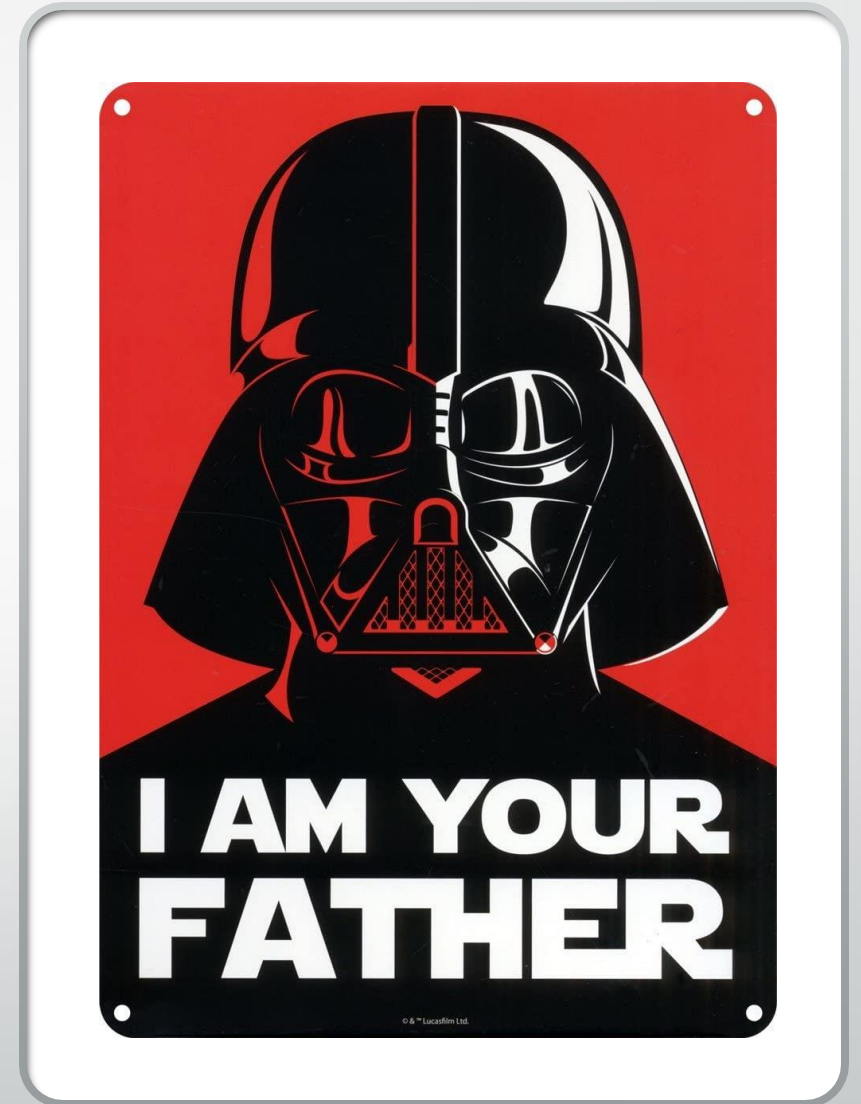
- [Takeielts.britishcouncil.org](https://takeielts.britishcouncil.org) or search: "Take IELTS"
- Click "Book IELTS" at the top
- Choose United Kingdom from the drop-down menu
- Choose the right exam
 - UKVI or non-UKVI
 - Academic
- Choose your exam centre (London Central)
- Choose your exam date (28th May)
- Fill in the personal details

Filling in the form

- Make sure your name is ***exactly*** as it appears in your passport
 - Or you will not be allowed to take the exam
- Make sure that you use the **ID** you will take with you on the day
- Make sure that you send a copy of your results to the school
 - Make sure that you set your home/postal address as the school:
 - EF International Language Campus, Pullens Lane, Oxford, OX3 0DT

Under 18s

- You will need to come to me to register for you
 - So that I can give my consent
 - I am *in loco parentis*
- Come to the Academic Office to complete the booking
- Bring:
 - Your passport
 - Your payment (debit or credit) card
 - Your UK phone number






Let me show you...

Wait. I have to pay?

- Only temporarily
- The University Preparation course includes one (1) exam in the course fee
- **BUT** IELTS will only communicate directly with the candidate (you)
- So you pay online then get a refund from your EF Sales Office
- Send your payment confirmation to EF *in your country*
- You must send this evidence in order to get the refund

The Speaking exam

- If you're booking in London,
 - Book your Speaking for the same day
 - Choose a fairly early speaking time so that you don't have to travel back super late
 - I will book the return coach to meet the **last Speaking** candidate who is travelling with us



**Please also send confirmation of
your exam date, location & speaking time
to me**

So that I know that you've booked it and can organize
transport

Also tell me if you have booked Paper-based or Computer-delivered
as I'm tracking student preferences

Travelling with us to your exam: London Central

- You need to arrive in London to register at **08:30**
- We will ***leave*** school at about 06:15
 - Meet at school at 06:00
- We will go direct to the exam centre
 - Walk with you from the drop-off point
 - Wait with you until you have registered
- We will meet you at the end and bring you back
 - O18s can stay in London longer & come back yourself if you like

Travelling on your own to your exam: London Central

- You need to arrive to register at **08:30**
- Take the Oxford Tube (from opposite Oxford Brookes) at about 06:00
- Get off the bus at **Marble Arch**
- Take the **Central Line** to Holborn
- Walk (5 min) down High Holborn to International House, **Stukeley St**
 - Past Sainsbury's and the Princess Louise pub
 - Turn left into Smart's Place

Help on the day

- Obviously, I can't help you in the exam
- BUT if you have any problems, there will be a special UP emergency phone number on this day ***only for IELTS takers***
